VA Mobile Clinic Open in Globe

The Carl T. Hayden VA Medical Center now provides health care services to eligible veterans in the Globe-Miami area via the VA Mobile Medical Clinic. The Mobile Medical Clinic is a full-size bus with two examination rooms that is staffed to provide primary care services to veterans and can serve up to 700 patients.

The bus is parked at Veterans of Foreign Wars (VFW) Post 1704, which is located at 707 S. Broad Street in Globe, Arizona.
